

2nd work report
on the construction of one building holding 1 classroom only and toilets
for the public primary school of N’Gbeho
District of Godomey
municipality of Abomey-Calavi

After the New Year holidays, the masons return to N’Gbeho to start the plastering work. Since there is only one classroom, the work inside the building is progressing quickly. The exterior takes more time because the foundation is high. Nevertheless, everything is mastered without much difficulty.



Finally, the floors and the staircase are cemented.



Ever since the construction team got back to the site, we've been discussing how to build a toilet here in the swamp area. The existing toilet was built by the municipality. The pit is built in the water. It is not certain whether the pit is bricked. Our employees tell that it is filled with water. Finally we decide to build the pit over the sod. A 50 cm thick foundation is poured with Sikalite and Sikalutex. The pit is also plastered with Sikalite and Sikalutex.



A large top slab is poured to provide space for the stairways.



The toilet house is built above this. Since the school is not far from the sea, we put on a roof made of Eternit panels. Corrugated iron would rust too quickly in the salty air. The railings are installed.

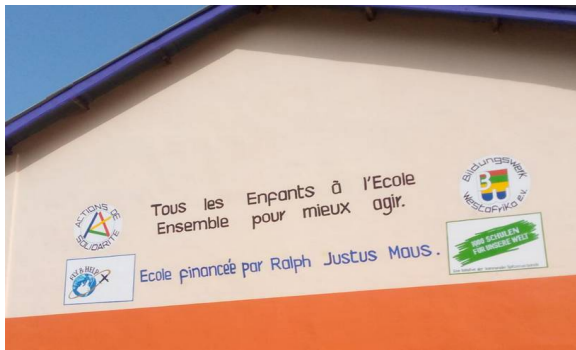
The painters begin painting the building.
