After the New Year holidays, our construction team returned to Sinwe-Lego. They were greeted with much joy and relief, as work could finally resume. The sand, which had been purchased in advance, was sifted, while the doors and shutters were placed. Then, the interior walls of the classrooms were plastered.



Next it is the turn of the exterior walls. Since the exterior walls are exposed to rain the plaster is mixed with Sikalite and Sikalatex to prevent water penetration.



To mark the end the floors are cemented.







Work on the toilets is also going smoothly.



After the plaster has dried, the painters will travel to Sinwe-Lego and enchant the buildings there.
