Preschool of Adjigo, District of Atokolibé, Municipality of Bante, Republic of Benin

Starting from Cotonou, we drive north for approximately 200 km on the arterial road, passing Godomey, Abomey-Calavi, Allada, and Bohicon to Dassa-Zoumé. At the large roundabout, a road turns west toward Savalou. We take this road and use the bypass around the city of Savalou. We drive another 45 km north to the small town of Gouka. After the Gouka elementary school, we take the third road to the right. We follow this road until we see the Adjigo preschool and elementary school on the right, which are located on the same promesis.

The preschool was registered under the number 3267MEF/MEMP/DC/SGM/DPP/SA on December 16, 2013. The 81 children (36 of them girls) are housed in a red clay building with plastered walls. The building has two entrance doors, but there is only one small room inside. The roof has sunk, and the walls have large cracks. At times of rain or wind, the children must seek shelter outside, as the building is in danger of collapsing.

The district head and the parents present are asking us to build a solid building with comfortable classrooms and restrooms for their children. Therefore, we are planning

- 1. The construction of a building holding two classrooms, plus an office for the principal and a storage room for teaching materials. The classrooms will be decorated with large murals. Cost: € 36,000
- 2. Construction of a toilet block with four (04) cubicles Cost: € 6,000
- 3. electrical power supply: € 3,000
- 4. Furnishings with playhouses, cabinets, shelves, and play equipment Cost: € 5,000
- 5. Personnel: Construction supervision 250 € x 6 = 1,500 €, construction technician 230 € x 6 = 1,380 € total: 2,880 €
- 6. Costs for construction inspections: € 3,000

The total project cost is € 55,880. 25% of the total cost is € 13,970
